

## Acts 2:14-15 What is "wine"?

## 1. When the Bible talks about "wine", what exactly is it talking about?

- a. There are \_\_\_\_\_\_ different Hebrew terms in the Old testament which are translated as "wine", and \_\_\_\_\_\_ Greek terms in the New Testament.

- b. There were three basic categories of "wine" in Jesus day.

- I Timothy 5:23 "Stop drinking only water, use a little wine because of your stomach"
- 2. Wine used in celebration, ceremony, and medicine

John 2:1-10	Jesus changed water into wine at a
Exodus 29:40	a quarter of a hin of wine as a drink
Proverbs 31:6	Let beer be for those who are perishing, wine for those who are in anguish! ( & pain)
Psalm 104:14-15	He makes grass grow for the cattle, and plants for people to cultivate— bringing forth food from the earth: <u>wine that</u> <u>gladdens human hearts</u> , oil to make their faces shine, and bread that sustains their hearts.
1 Timothy 3:8	In the same way, deacons are to be worthy of respect, sincere, not indulging in much wine, and not pursuing dishonest gain.

3. Wine (beer, strong drink) used for the purpose of getting \_\_\_\_\_

Ephesians 5:18	Do not get on wine, which leads to <u>debauchery</u> .
Proverbs 20:1	Wine is a and beer a; whoever is led astray by them is not wise.
Proverbs 23:29-30	Who has woe? Who has sorrow? Who has strife? Who has complaints? Who has needless bruises? Who has bloodshot eyes? Those who <u>linger</u> over wine, who <u>go to sample</u> bowls of mixed wine.
Proverbs 23:31	Do not <u>gaze</u> at wine when it is red, when it sparkles in the cup, when it goes down smoothly! (, thing for fun)

## 2. To be a Biblical, modern day, consumer of alcohol, you must understand that:
