Ephe	esus – Where Pastor John for nearly 20 years
1.	Ephesus was crossroad for Trade and Travel routes in the ancient world.
2.	Ephesus became the cultural and economic Mecca of the Empire in Asia.
3.	Emperor Domitian ruled over the Roman Empire and spent a lot of time in Ephesus.
4.	Domitian took the Roman Empire to its highest levels of worship.
Obst	cacles in Ephesus to the common believer:
1.	visitors were required to take a ritual bath upon entering the Magnesian Gate to be <i>clean</i> before the Greek and Roman gods (Artemis, Diana, etc.)
2.	As you entered the Agora (100 square meter market) you would be required to burn incense Caesar as god, <i>acknowledging before men</i> that Caesar was god.
3.	After bathing and burning incense, you would receive an <i>ink stain marking you as</i> to buy, sell, and travel freely in Ephesus.
	a. The Jews by tradition called anyone who demanded self-worship a "Beast"b. The ink stain would have been called the "Mark of the Beast"
4.	The Roman Emperor Domitian was absolutely one of Satan's antichrists
Goď	's message to Believers living in Ephesus: Revelation 4-5
1.	Domitian claimed to be a god. But God it by revealing his Heavenly and Eternal throne room to John.
2.	Domitian had a 24 member worship team singing his praises. But God had 24
	wearing crowns, sitting on thrones worshipping Him, not to mention living
	creatures, thunder and lightning, an choir, and a worldwide group of backup singers who all worship Him with enthusiasm and without coercion

3.	Domitian was the only one worthy to open his own scrolls and break his royal seal. But was worthy to open God Almighty's scroll and open its Divine seals.
4.	Domitian claimed to control the future. God actually does control the future, and the future to John as each of the seven seals are broken.
5.	Domitian needed a 27 foot statue so that he would be remembered by after his death. But God needs no such monument to be remembered after his death because Jesus rose from the dead and is, and the Holy Spirit lives within every believer.
6.	Domitian was worshipped out of fear of torture and death if they did not. Christians worship God as a free will that He allows them to make on a daily basis.
7.	Domitian killed those who opposed him, God – through Jesus Christ – died himself so that those oppose Him, also have a to be reconciled and saved.
8.	Domitian, who could not kill John, tried to silence him with exile. But God used John, while in Domitian's exile, to write a book of prophesy and a call to salvation that has been silenced or disregarded.
Big Id	lea for the Ephesians:
unive	tian is a playing in a sandbox when compared to the GOD who rules the rse, and with Jesus who came to this Earth, and died so that our sins could be forgiven. nerwards, one of the greatest humans of all time, was a joke when compared to God.
