

- 1. In the past 8 years, HBC has:

Col. 3:23-24	Whatever you do, work at it with all your heart, as working for the Lord, not for human masters, since you know that you <b>will receive an inheritance</b> from the Lord

## The common thread in all of these passages is this:

There is no \_\_\_\_\_\_ to the Christian life, or the church age, or our instruction for life, until the return of Christ and/or our entrance into \_\_\_\_\_\_.

- Rev. 3:1-2 "To the angel of the church in Sardis write: These are the words of him who holds the seven spirits of God and the seven stars. I know your deeds; you have a reputation of being alive, but you are dead. Wake up! Strengthen what remains and is about to die, for I have found your deeds unfinished in the sight of my God.
- Rev 3:15-16 I know your deeds, that **you are neither cold nor hot**. I wish you were either one or the other! So, because you are lukewarm—neither hot nor cold—I am about to spit you out of my mouth.

## The Lessons for our church, and you as its members – are these:

- 1. If we choose to be happy and content with what's already been accomplished, then we will look good from the outside, while we are \_\_\_\_\_\_ on the inside. (Sardis)
