Other Translations:

- NLT: Don't copy the behavior and customs of this world, but let God transform you into a new person by changing the way you think. Then you will learn to know God's will for you, which is good and pleasing and perfect.
- AMP: Do not be conformed to this world (this age), [fashioned after and adapted to its external, superficial customs], but be transformed (changed) by the entire renewal of your mind [by its new ideals and its new attitude], so that you may prove [for yourselves] what is the good and acceptable and perfect will of God, even the thing which is good and acceptable and perfect in His sight for you.
- PDV: Don't be satisfied being the person you were before Jesus, and don't allow yourself to become a Christian that influenced by anything other than God. Instead, gain a daily spiritual victory by regularly refueling your mind with Godly and righteous data input. Then you will know how to live a life pleasing to God and be able to make good decisions.
