In the most general since:

- 1. A man is a <u>male</u>, who is both <u>capable</u> of, and <u>fulfills</u>, the <u>responsibilities and roles</u> of a male adult.
- 2. A woman is a <u>female</u>, who is both <u>capable</u> of, and <u>fulfills</u>, the <u>responsibilities and roles</u> of a female adult.
- 3. Factors in both categories include age, God given roles, and capacity.

Review and Application:

- 1. A man is a male, who is both capable of, and fulfills, the responsibilities and roles of a male adult.
- 2. A woman is a female, who is both capable of, and fulfills, the responsibilities and roles of a female adult.
- 3. Age matters, but does not give a magic number.
 - Capacity matters, but does not fully make someone an adult
 - Practice matters, but does not fully make someone an adult
- 4. To be a man, or woman, you must be of age, possess the capacity, practice the Biblical roles as God has given them, and accept the responsibility that is automatically associated.
