



## I believe I am FORGIVEN, help me Leave any doubt behind forever.

**Big Idea:** At the moment of my salvation, I am \_\_\_\_\_ forgiven of all my personal sin, whether it be in my **past**, the **present**, or even in the **future**.

### Colossians 2:12-14

**When you were dead in your sins** and in the uncircumcision of your flesh, God made you alive with Christ. He forgave us **all our sins**, having canceled the charge of our **legal indebtedness**, which stood against us and condemned us; he has taken it away, nailing it to the cross.

1. \_\_\_\_\_ of your sins were future sins when Jesus died for their forgiveness.
2. "All our sins" has \_\_\_\_\_ time limitations, \_\_\_\_\_ use by date, or expiration.
3. God's forgiveness legally meets \_\_\_\_\_ requirements for justice.

### Hebrews 10:11-14

Day after day every priest stands and performs his religious duties; again and again he offers the same sacrifices, **which can never take away sins**. But when **this priest** had offered **for all time one sacrifice for sins**, he sat down at the right hand of God, and since that time he waits for his enemies to be made his footstool. For **by one sacrifice he has made perfect forever those who are being made holy**.

1. Temple sacrifices \_\_\_\_\_ forgave anyone of their sins.

### Matthew 26:28

This is my blood of the covenant, which is poured out for many for the forgiveness of sins.

### Acts 10:43

All the prophets testify about him that everyone who believes in him receives forgiveness of sins through his name.”

### Ephesians 1:7

In him we have redemption **through his blood**, the forgiveness of sins, in accordance with the riches of **God's grace**.

### Colossians 1:13-14

For he has *rescued* us from the **dominion of darkness** and brought us into the **kingdom of the Son he loves**, in whom we have redemption, the forgiveness of sins.

### Psalms 103:8-12

The Lord is compassionate and gracious, slow to anger, abounding in love. He will not always accuse, nor will he harbor his anger forever; **he does not treat us as our sins deserve**, or repay us according to our iniquities. For as high as the heavens are above the earth, so great is his love for those who fear him, **as far as the east is from the west, so far has he removed our transgressions from us**.

1. Forgiveness is an act of God's \_\_\_\_\_.
2. God's \_\_\_\_\_ has a measurable illustration. (... heavens are above the Earth)
3. God's illustrated forgiveness has \_\_\_\_\_ end. (as far as the East is from the West)

### Application:

1. I should never \_\_\_\_\_ Satan to tell me that God has not, will not, or no longer forgives me of my sin.
2. Jesus' forgiveness never has a \_\_\_\_\_ attached to it in scripture. (unless, until, if )
3. I must treat my forgiveness as a **DONE DEAL**, and \_\_\_\_\_ my attention on God's commands, principles, boundaries, desires, and instructions regarding life \_\_\_\_\_ salvation.
