

## Peter Escapes Prison Acts 12:5-19

- 1. Always take time to notice the "little words" in scripture?
  - a. SO, BUT (vs 5)
  - b. SLEEPING (vs 6)
  - c. STRUCK (vs 7)
  - Application: a. When a "but" is \_\_\_\_\_, God's got is covered.
    - b. \_\_\_\_\_ can "sleep" while the enemy is attacking.
    - c. My new goal and prayer, is for the **<u>necessity</u>** of a "strike".

## 2. "The church was earnestly praying ..." (vs 5)

- a. There is \_\_\_\_\_\_ in the prayers of "The Church" (Ashley, Andrew, Corporate Prayer)
- b. Earnestly: i. Resulting from or showing sincere and intense
  - ii. To a greater extent or more intensely than \_\_\_\_\_
- c. Many people had \_\_\_\_\_\_ and were praying (vs 12)
- Application: a. Never \_\_\_\_\_\_ to call on the church to pray.
  - b. When asked, apply earnestness **appropriately**.

c. \_\_\_\_\_ get your small groups involved with your needs.

## 3. John Mark (vs 12)

- a. Future **disappointment** to Paul on his first missionary journey (Acts 15:37-38)
- b. Future \_\_\_\_\_\_ and close friend of Paul (2 Timothy 4:11)
- c. Future \_\_\_\_\_\_ in ministry with Peter, and author of the Gospel of Mark.
- Application: a. "Future you" does \_\_\_\_\_ have to look life "past you".
  - b. Philippians 1:6 "... he who began a good work in you will carry it on to completion until the day of Christ Jesus."

## 4. "But the word of God continued to spread and flourish" (vs 24)

- a. Not despite of James death, but because of
- b. Not despite Peter's arrest and escape, but **because of**
- c. Not despite Herod's persecution, but because of
- d. Not despite Herod's strange death, but because of
- Application: a. \_\_\_\_\_\_ is "bad news" in the hand of God.

Romans 8:28-30 And we know that in all things God works for the good of those who love him, who have been called according to his purpose. For those God foreknew he also predestined to be conformed to the image of his Son, that he might be the firstborn among many brothers and sisters. And those he predestined, he also called; those he called, he also justified; those he justified, he also glorified.

- We need to \_\_\_\_\_\_\_ thinking that God will honor us for our love and devotion by giving us easy living, blessings beyond compare, and removing trials/tribulations.
- c. We need to \_\_\_\_\_\_ realizing that God is honoring us when HE deems us worthy to go through a trial or tribulation, for the purpose of honoring God and accomplishing HIS will through us.
