Psalms 29:1-2 Ascribe to the Lord, you heavenly beings, ascribe to the Lord **glory and strength.** Ascribe to the Lord the glory due his name; worship the Lord in the splendor of **his holiness.**

1. Grateful _____ to God
 - a. Illustrated by “bowing down”, as in Revelation 22:7-9 and Joshua 5:14-15
 - b. This worship communicates a dependance on God, acknowledgement of His greatness, and our submission to His will and commands.
 - c. It can be accomplished in prayer, singing, oration, obedience, and attitude.

2. _____ to others
 - a. Illustrated in the O.T. by sacrifices, rituals, festivals, etc.
Illustrated in the N.T. by a living sacrifice, loving one another, keeping commandments, spiritual gifts, fruits of the spirit
 - b. This worship communicates a change in me as the result of my relationship with God and his interaction with me.
 - c. This can be accomplished with righteous living, righteous interactions with others, service in the church, obedience, as well as Godly attitudes and motives.
 - d. 1 Samuel 15:22 But Samuel replied: “Does the Lord delight in burnt offerings and sacrifices as much as in obeying the Lord? **To obey is better than sacrifice, and to heed is better than the fat of rams.**

 - a. Illustrated by the heart attitude described in Deut 5:29, 6:2, and Ecc 12:13
 - b. This worship is communicated in our attitude towards God, but is demonstrated in our obedience to His commands.
 - c. This can be accomplished in almost every area of life.

4. _____ interaction with God
 - a. Illustrated by the formation of churches in Acts, Letters to churches in Revelation, and in the Leadership of churches in Ephesians 4:11-13.
 - b. This worship is communicated in corporate singing, prayer, fellowship, scripture reading, offering, and instruction.
 - c. This is accomplished in church, as in Hebrews 10:24-25
