## 1. John 13: 10-11 Jesus \_\_\_\_\_ the disciples feet

- Context:**
1. Not only had the disciples been arguing about who among them was, the \_\_\_\_\_.

- Context:**
1. Jesus has already risen from the dead

4. **Matthew 27:11-55 Jesus endured an unfair and illegal trial.**

- Context:**

- d. Who should have **held court**, rather than been tried in a kangaroo court
- e. Who should have been **pampered and worshipped**, rather than abused
