## Living Waters

Bringing Life-Giving Water to People Who Thirst

According to UNICEF (United Nations International Children's Emergency Fund), less than half (44%) of Chad's rural population have access to improved drinking water source. This means that most of Chad's rural population is drinking water from a source that is contaminated and unhealthy. Deadly waterborne diseases such as cholera and typhoid run rampant. One in five Chadian children will not live to see their fifth birthday. The Chadian people are thirsty for good water.

Living Waters is a ministry of LBIM that incorporates the physical installation of water wells in needy communities in Chad with an ongoing commitment to evangelistic ministry in these same communities. The purpose is to meet both a real physical need in the provision of a well that will quench a temporal thirst, and also to meet a real spiritual need in the provision of the Gospel message of Christ with those who live in a context where they may otherwise die without ever hearing the eternally thirst quenching Gospel.
