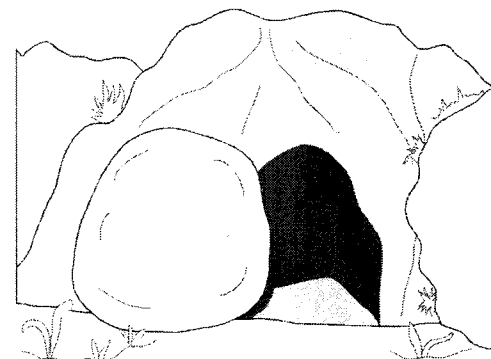

Sermon Notes: Mark 16:1-8
"He Has Risen"

Mourn the buried Christ

Rejoice in the risen Christ

Proclaim the risen Christ

Cross-References:

- Matthew 28:1-8; Luke 24:1-9; John 20:1-10 – Parallel passages
- Matthew 12:39-40, 16:21; John 2:18-21– Jesus foretells his own resurrection
- Psalm 16:8-11; Job 19:23-26; Isaiah 53:8-10 – The Old Testament foretells the resurrection of the Messiah

What does the text say?

What did Jesus say made him and his disciples alike? (vv. 21, 23)

Why wasn't Thomas with the other disciples? How did Jesus deal with Thomas? (vv. 24-25, 27-29)

Why did John set out to record the good news of Jesus? (v. 31)

What does the text mean?

Verse 21 says that Jesus' disciples are "sent". What are we sent to do? (See Matthew 28:19-20 Acts 13:47, 15:14-18; 1 Corinthians 9:16)

What is the remedy for someone who doubts the truth of scripture? (John 20:30-31; 1 Corinthians 1:17-19; Romans 10:13-15)

How would you draw a connection between verse 31 of this passage and Thomas' doubts?

What does the text do?

Using Thomas as an example, if someone doubts Christ's resurrection, does that mean that person will be irreversibly damned?

Can a person doubt certain parts of scripture and yet still be saved?
