

Exodus20:18-21

- Now all the people witnessed the thunderings, the lightning flashes, the sound of the trumpet, and the mountain smoking; and when the people saw it, they trembled and stood afar off. Then they said to Moses,"You speak with us, and we will hear; but let not God speak with us, lest we die."

The Midrash of the Universe







He determines the number of the stars and calls them. each by name. Great is our L-rd and mighty in power; his understanding has no limit. (Psalm 147)


The Human Body


- 100,000,000,000,000100 trillion cells

- Yeshua: All things made through Him and the elements maintained by Him.
















What is Man?


