



# Fast Track to Jerusalem – Part 1

## Acts 20 (Bible Gateway – NIV by Dramatized)

**Acts 20:1-16** Explains how Paul got from Ephesus to Greece, and then back to Miletus.

- Without this Acts 20:17 would be very \_\_\_\_\_
- We are transitioning in the narrative to the next big events in Paul's life – which will take place in \_\_\_\_\_
- One event seems too noteworthy not to mention – **Eutychus**

**Acts 20:17 – 37** Paul says goodbye to his dear friends (Elders) in Ephesus and gives this his final instructions for leading \_\_\_\_\_ congregation.
