



# Finishing up with Review, Additions, and Clarifications

## Review:

1. When God assigned our gender and/or leadership roles and responsibilities, he did not assign value, he \_\_\_\_\_ His will for the family, society, and the church.

## Additions: The Natural order of things:

- Stage One: Childhood
- a. When adults (mostly parents) raise up children in the way they should go (Proverbs 22:6), teach them to know, understand, and love the commands, principles, and doctrines of the Lord (Deut. 6:1-9), and pass along their faith (2 Timothy 1:5); so that when it is time, children \_\_\_\_\_ leave their father and mother behind and become one flesh with their **life long spouse** (Matthew 19:4-6).
  - b. When children have the \_\_\_\_\_ to learn, grow, and thrive under the protective covering of their parents, and adults, who love them.

- Stage Two: Adulthood
- a. When a man or woman embraces both the identity and gender that God \_\_\_\_\_ to them.

(Cancer, loss, relational trouble, depression, cultural chaos, etc.)

Stage Three: Senior Adulthood

- b. When we learn to \_\_\_\_\_ those who come behind us through prayer, wisdom when asked for, and the example of a life well lived for Christ.
- c. When we teach those younger how to live a life pleasing to God – but only to those who are ready and willing to listen. (Titus 2:1-8)

**Clarifications:**
