Revelation 11 “The Two Witnesses”

Revelation 11:1-2 I was given a reed like a measuring rod and was told, “Go and measure the temple of God and the altar, with its worshipers. But exclude the outer court; do not measure it, because it has been given to the Gentiles. They will trample on the holy city for 42 months

What I know:

1. There is a _____ temple.
 - a. Daniel 9:27 The Jewish temple will be _____ up until the 3.5 year mark of the tribulation.

Sometime in the third year of the tribulation, temple worship will be _____ by the antichrist

1290 days (about 3.5 years) later, the “**abomination that causes desolation**” will occur.
 - b. II Thess 2:4 The abomination is the Antichrist setting himself up in God’s Temple, _____ himself to be God.
