Bringing **Faith** Home

Ezekiel 17:22-24

What does the text say?

What kind of shoot (twig/branch/sprig) is God going to choose? (v. 22)

Where will this shoot be planted? What will it do? (v. 23)

How will the rest of the trees respond to this shoot? (v. 24)

What does the text mean?

How does the prophecy of the shoot correspond to Jesus? (Isaiah 27:6; Jeremiah 23:5-6; Isaiah 53:1-6)

What does it mean that the birds will nest in and under its branches? (Psalm 116:7-9; Matthew 11:28-30; Hebrews 4:1-11; Romans 5:1)

How can it be that the whole world will see and recognize the messiah? (Isaiah 55:11-13; Galatians 3:27-29; Matthew 25:45-46)

What does the text do?

Consider those times when you were a dry tree and the gospel caused you to flourish; Those times when you thought you were a green tree and God's Word dried you up.
