

## Acts 2:1-13

Tongues - "What does this mean?"

## Context

1. Day of Pentecost: $\qquad$ days after the Passover
$\qquad$ days after Jesus assention

Shortly after Mathias was chosen to replace Judas
2. "They" (vs 1):

Some say the $\qquad$ from Acts 1:15 (120 believers)

Others say the $\qquad$ from Acts 1:14 (the 11 - No Judas or Mathias)

Most say it was the Apostles from Acts 1:14 $\qquad$ Mathias
3. "Sound like the Blowing of a violent wind": Think BLAST, EXPLOSION, HURRICANE, BLIZZARD But $\qquad$ wind
4. "Filled the House": It $\qquad$ them

It 'baptized' them (Mark 1:8, Acts 1:5)
5. Never in the $\qquad$ history of God, has the Holy Spirit appeared as a tongue of fire, or has any man whom He filled spoke in 'tongues' before this day. This is brand new.
6. The word "tongues" literally means " $\qquad$ ".
a. $\qquad$ rhythmic, punctuated, enunciated
b. $\qquad$ to a people group
c. "Own Language" in Acts 2:6 indicates a specific $\qquad$

Most of those present reacted appropriately to this display of God's power. They were amazed and perplexed, and ask the question, "What does this mean?"

1. Two more $\qquad$ made by Jesus have been kept.
a. Matthew 16:18 I will build my $\qquad$ ...
b. John 15:26

The Holy Spirit $\qquad$ come
i. teaching all things (they need to know to be successful)
ii. reminding them of all Jesus said
2. The Holy Spirit did something very special to and for the apostles on this day.

What exactly did He do to the apostles?
a. This is $\qquad$ when the Apostles received the Holy Spirit, that was in John 20:22
b. This is the first time the Apostles were $\qquad$ with the Holy Spirit (Acts 2:4)
c. This filling of the Holy Spirit was a one of a kind, $\qquad$ event, in church history
i. Actual languages were spoken by men with no language training (vs 7)
ii. The number of languages exceeded the number of people
iii. Tongues of fire physically signaled the miracle being done
iv. God identified exactly who He was using
d. The Holy Spirit was in $\qquad$ of the languages and the message. (Acts 2:4)

What exactly did he do for the apostles?
a. He inaugurated the $\qquad$ that had been promised.
b. He identified the $\qquad$ of the church by the symbol of the tongue and the miracle of the languages.
c. He gave the apostles the $\qquad$ they needed to lead.
d. He gave the church a $\qquad$ to accomplishing the Great Commission.
3. The church has $\qquad$ been started by God.
a. It now has leadership and membership.
b. It's connectivity / source of binding together is the $\qquad$
i. Apostles received Holy Spirit in John 2:4
ii. New believers will receive Holy Spirit at Salvation (Acts 2:38)
c. The CHURCH is $\qquad$ an organization of common knowledge, but a common SPIRIT which is given at salvation.
4. In the very face of God, actually experiencing a miracle manifested by the Holy Spirit, some will still $\qquad$ God and his salvation.
