#### **Unity in Christ:**

Where is the centre of our identity? Are we defined primarily by who we are in Christ?

Are we energised by being a Christian or does it drain us? Is it a relationship or a religion?

#### **Unity within the Church:**

The Church is "the body of Christ":

"God has put the body together, giving greater honour to the parts that lacked it, so that there should be no division in the body, but that its parts should have equal concern for each other. If one part suffers, every part suffers with it; if one part is honoured, every part rejoices with it. If one part suffers, every part suffers with it; if one part is honoured, every part rejoices with it. Now you are the body of Christ, and each one of you is a part of it."

## **Unity within the Church:**

Are we secure with our place within the body? Does each of us really know how important we are within that body?

Are we expectant to hear from God about things concerning the body?

Have we truly got that sense of connection - love, responsibility, care - for the other members of the body?

## Walking alongside each other:

"bear with the failings of the weak and not to please ourselves":

- walking alongside one another;
- holding each other up;
- encouraging & supporting;
- striving to move together and not leaving anyone behind.

## **Putting others first:**

"please our neighbours for their good, to build them up":

- speaking the truth in love;
- why are we choosing to say something;
- will it build someone up, will it edify or destroy;
- is it for their good or for our own;
- how are we sharing will they be able to receive it easily;
- believing the bestaof each other and chroningthetro take god's desire for a community of Believers

## **Applying Scripture:**

"For everything that was written in the past was written to teach us":

- "All Scripture is God-breathed and is useful for teaching, rebuking, correcting and training in righteousness" 2Tim3:16 NIVUK
- Nb. "Everything" + "All";
- have we got a teachable spirit;
- willing to receive through scripture and via our brothers and sisters in Christ;
- have we atrophied or fossilised;
- thirst to understand to be the time of believers of believers

### **Discipline & Commitment:**

"through the endurance taught in the Scriptures and the encouragement they provide we might have hope":

- "We remember before our God and Father your work produced by faith, your labour prompted by love, and your endurance inspired by hope in our Lord Jesus Christ." 1Thes1:3;
- Nobody ever promised it was going to be easy;
- Focussed like Olympic athletes;
- What do we hope for?
- Where is our confidence?

#### The mind of Christ:

"May the God who gives endurance and encouragement give you the same attitude of mind toward each other that Christ Jesus had":

"Therefore if you have any encouragement from being united with Christ, if any comfort from his love, if any common sharing in the Spirit, if any tenderness and compassion, then make my joy complete by being likeminded, having the same love, being one in spirit and of one mind. **Do** nothing out of selfish ambition or vain conceit. Rather, in humility value others above yourselves." Phil2:1-3 NIVUK

### **Glorifying God:**

"so that with one mind and one voice you may glorify the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ":

- united in Christ;
- sharing in The Holy Spirit;
- being like-minded;
- being one in spirit and of one mind;
- united together as the ecclesia but also being in unity with Christ;
- our lives glorify Christ and Father God, both individually and collectively.

#### Accepting one another:

"Accept one another, then, just as Christ accepted you, in order to bring praise to God":

- Everyone is made in the image of God and dearly loved by the very Son of God;
- Outworking of Christian faith: transforming lives through the love of Christ;
- The beauty and blessing of harmony;
- The pain and anguish of disunity.

#### **Summary:**

Our lives and our witness bring praise to God the Father and raise high the name of God the Son when we allow the love of Christ to flow in and through us. **Unity in Christ & Unity in the Church**;

- Walking alongside one another;
- Putting others first;
- Applying Scripture;
