Summary:

God's vision for SCF:

- -members of SCF will grow (stronger and deeper) as disciples of Christ: members of SCF will grow as disciples, and their relationship with God will deepen; they will have a passion to be ever more Christ centred. As members of the church family go about their daily lives they will exert Christ's influence. SCF will be a missional family... Every aspect of our plans and purposes will be founded on our deep desire to be in God's will and to do His calling; everything will continue to start with, and to be covered by, prayer.
- -people will see Christ-in-us transform lives:
- -The Bridge is to be a light in the community (Isaiah 60:1): the people of SCF are being called to develop resources that reach people physically, socially and spiritually;
- -everyone will know about The Bridge and SCF:
- -government and community agencies will come to us for help.

Why do it?

.... Because we don't have a choice:

We are called to:

- "loose the chains of injustice and untie the cords of the yoke, to set the oppressed free and break every yoke"; and
- be Christ's hands feet and voice for those in need "For I was hungry and you gave me something to eat, I was thirsty and you gave me something to drink, I was a stranger and you invited me in, I needed clothes and you clothed me, I was ill and you looked after me, I was in prison and you came to visit me."

Why do it?

We are also called to:

- be salt and light.
- share the Gospel of Jesus Christ;
 plus
- we are <u>commanded</u> to make disciples; and
- "..From everyone who has been given much, much will be demanded; and from the one who has been entrusted with much, much more will be asked."

Safe Spaces:

A network of spaces - including our **homes** and **work places** - with **The Bridge as the hub**.

Safe spaces:

Accessible to everyone where needs are met with real love and care for the whole person including all those who they care about



Safe Spaces:

Where everyone is empowered to make a difference in their own lives and in the lives of those around them

A community where people can "be" without having to "believe" or even to "belong" where they experience Christ and learn to trust through relationship

Safe Spaces:

A pathway
for Christ to walk upon
where the Gospel is lived out
leading to a place where the Gospel is preached and
people can discover Christ for themselves

The Bridge:

"An attractive & accessible multi purpose environment that welcomes people of all ages and backgrounds (race, culture, abilities) ... that will help the church to contribute to the spiritual, moral, social & physical well being of the community.

Through providing a meeting place for worship, friendship, prayer training and practical help."

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Impacting our neighbours:

- Being congruent in our words and deeds;
- Being in-step with God's heart in tune with The Holy Spirit;
- Understanding and respect respect is an essential element in building trust;
- Respecting someone is not the same as agreeing with their views or their lifestyle;
- Just the right sized helping of truth in love at the right time.

Using God's gifts:

- God has granted that the majority of us in SCF have homes;
- Having the heart of Christ for our neighbours;
- Care for the Family's "Kitchen Table Project";
- Our places of work or study;
- The Bridge as a "hub".

The Bridge - Extending the tent:

- Needs in the community are an opportunity to extend God's use of The Bridge;
- Opportunities to build new relationships;
- <u>Examples:</u> Bereavement Breast Feeding Community & Lively Hearts Lunches;
- Different badges but ALL compatible with God's vision for SCF.
