Sunday:

King Jesus COMING IN

MATTHEW 21:6-9

⁶ The disciples went and did as Jesus had instructed them. ⁷ They brought the donkey and the colt and placed their cloaks on them for Jesus to sit on. ⁸ A very large crowd spread their cloaks on the road, while others cut branches from the trees and spread them on the road.

MATTHEW 21:6-9

⁹ The crowds that went ahead of him and those that followed shouted,

“Hosanna to the Son of David!”

“Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord!”

“Hosanna in the highest heaven!”



Monday:

King Jesus CLEANING UP

MATTHEW 21:12-13

¹² Jesus entered the temple courts and drove out all who were buying and selling there. He overturned the tables of the money changers and the benches of those selling doves.

MATTHEW 21:12-13

¹³ “It is written,” he said to them,
“My house will be called a house of prayer,
but you are making it ‘a den of robbers.’”

Researcher Christian Smith's book, *Soul Searching* a faith characterized by “moralistic, therapeutic deism.”

According to this view of God, if we live good lives and if we're kind to others, then God will provide “therapeutic benefits” to us like self-esteem and happiness. Other than that, God is not involved much in our world.

But Smith also found that many young Americans' prayers lacked any sense of repentance or adoration. Smith writes, "This is not a religion of repentance from sin." Again, Smith concludes that this "distant God" is "not demanding ... because his job is to solve problems and make people feel good. There is nothing here to evoke wonder and admiration."

MATTHEW 24:30

³⁰ “Then will appear the sign of the Son of Man in heaven. And then all the peoples of the earth will mourn when they see the Son of Man coming on the clouds of heaven, with power and great glory.



Wednesday:

King Jesus **CREATING SPACE**

MATTHEW 26:6-7

⁶ While Jesus was in Bethany in the home of Simon the Leper, ⁷ a woman came to him with an alabaster jar of very expensive perfume, which she poured on his head as he was reclining at the table.

ACTS 16:14

¹⁴ One of those listening was a woman from the city of Thyatira named Lydia, a dealer in purple cloth. She was a worshiper of God. **The Lord opened her heart** to respond to Paul's message.



Thursday:

King Jesus COMMITTING HELP

JOHN 14:15-17a

¹⁵ “If you love me, keep my commands. ¹⁶ And I will ask the Father, and he will give you another **advocate** to help you and be with you forever— ¹⁷ **the Spirit of truth.**

JOHN 14:25-26

²⁵ “All this I have spoken while still with you. ²⁶ But the Advocate, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in my name, will teach you all things and will remind you of everything I have said to you.

JOHN 16:7

⁷ But very truly I tell you, it is for your good that I am going away. Unless I go away, the **Advocate** will not come to you; but if I go, I will send him to you.
