




MATTHEW 26:36-39






MATTHEW 27:27-37


right hand. Then they knelt in front of him and mocked him. “Hail, king of the Jews!” they said.


³⁰ They spit on him, and took the staff and struck him on the head again and again.

³¹ After they had mocked him, they took off the robe and put his own clothes on him. Then they led him away to crucify him.









45 Now from the sixth hour darkness fell upon all the land until the ninth hour.





³⁰ Then you shall erect the tabernacle according to its plan which you have been shown in the mountain.





⁵ The mountains melted like wax at the presence of the Lord, at the presence of the Lord of the whole earth.








Full Circle
