Do Not Let Your Heart Be Troubled John 14:1-6

1.	in God God has always called men to believe in Him (John 14:1). God has always called men and women to look to Him to take care of our needs (Deut. 8:3; John 6:47-51). Our greatest need is to be delivered from the just consequences of the sins which we commit against God (Ezek. 18:4; Rev. 21:8). And God has always called us to look to Him for dealing with this problem of sin that we have created (Isa. 43:11, 25; 45:22).
2.	in Christ God's eternal and good plan was that the Son would be born into this world in order to fulfill every divine requirement and to reconcile sinful men with our holy God (John 1:14; Gal. 4:4). Believing in Jesus is the only way to receive forgiveness from sin to find fellowship with God (John 14:6).
3.	with the Spirit When you believe in Christ for salvation you are radically changed (2 Cor. 5:17), and God the Holy Spirit begins to dwell within you (1 Cor. 3:16). The evidence that the Holy Spirit is indwelling a person is the presence of the fruit of the Holy Spirit (Gal. 5:22-23). The extent to which you cling to God in faith has a direct impact upon your experience of the fruit of the Spirit (Rom. 15:13; cf. Eph.
