### START PRAYING: The Key Issue of Purity

Impurity, Adulteration, Decadence and Corruption are the opposites. Our human tendency is to persuade others to agree with our views. This leads to corruption, and all that is evil. God's purpose is to get us in line with His views, which are pure. Yet, so many Christians spend all of their time as pursuers of argumentation and not pursuers of holiness! If purity is being set apart for God's service then our prayers should be such that we should live as our life belongs to our Lord, as it does, and strive our best to be our best for His glory!
