The Christian and Infanticide Selected Scriptures

A. Murder and Killing: Human Death is Distinct

Man alone has been created in the image of God (Gen. 1:26-27). Before the Lord gave the Law to Moses where murder is forbidden (Ex. 20:13), God told Noah that murder is a capital crime (Gen. 9:6). Accidental or circumstantial killing is different than planned and executed murder (Ex. 21:12-14)

- B. Infanticide in the Bible
 - I. Infanticide was <u>Common</u> in the Ancient World (Lev. 18:21; Dt. 12:29-31)
 - II. Infanticide was a <u>Capital Crime</u> in Israel (Ex. 21:22-25; Lev. 20:1-5; Dt 18:10-13)
 - III. Infanticide was Shockingly Wicked in Israel (Jer. 7:31; 19:4-5)
 - IV. Infanticide became <u>Common Again</u> in Israel (2 Ki. 17:7-20; cf. 2 Ki. 16:2-3; 21:6; 2 Chron 28:3)
- C. Infanticide is a sin for which Christ Died (Isa. 53:11)
