Read this...

There is one God and He exists in three persons: The Father, The Son (Jesus), and the Holy Spirit. Whenever a person believes in Jesus and is saved, the Holy Spirit comes to live inside them! This is called the indwelling of the Spirit. This means that God is always with us no matter where we go! The Holy Spirit will help us remember to think about Jesus and what Jesus taught us. The Holy Spirit will help us to remember what is right and wrong. When we are about to do something we should not do, the Holy Spirit will warn us. This is called the conviction of the Holy Spirit. The Holy Spirit will also help us do right and live like Jesus lived. When the way we act and talk is like Jesus, we call that the Fruit of the Spirit.
