- The New Testament authors quote the OT as being God's word over 320 times
- The NT authors quote the OT passages over 1000
- The New Testament affirmed the Old Testament as divine.
- The New Testament authors affirm also that the NT is divine.

New Testament

- Galatian 1:12 Paul affirms the Gospel came form Jesus and not himself
- 1 Tim 5:18 Paul quotes the Gospel of Luke and calls is scripture
- 2 Peter 3:15-16 Peter calls Paul's writing scripture
- Jude 17 Refers to scripture and then quotes Paul
