


MESSAGE 2:

Contrasting the Fruit of a Carnal V Renewed Mind


Carnal Mindedness

- Calculated, reserved, suspicious
- Given to emotional ups & downs
- Inconsistent, unreliable, moody
- Often play with sinful thoughts
- Biblically opinionated or unsure
- Pray but lean on my own understanding
- Spectator, too 'dignified'

Renewed Mindedness

- Warm, serving, open demeanour
- Emotionally balanced
- Endure with joy and tenacity
- Thought-life harnessed
- Biblically but meekly wellinformed
- Revelation of Spirit codependence
- Worships deeply and gratefully

The 4 expressions of the flesh

Expression	Success rate of conquering it alone	Method
SIN	HIGH	Repentance & grace by faith
SELFISHNESS	MEDIUM	Repentance & grace by faith/ discipleship
SELF RIGHTEOUSNESS PRIDES + JUDGEMENTS	LOW/MEDIUM	Repentance & grace by faith/ deep discipleship
WOUNDS THAT CAUSE NEGATIVE BELIEFS	LOW	Special ministry to create a Truth Encounter



The source of contention ~ Pride

'Only by pride comes contention...'

PROVERBS 13:10

Different expressions of Pride

Arrogance;
Haughtiness;
Judging;
anger; being
puffed up etc

Forms of Pride

Fears including failure; Feeling: Useless; Rejected; Abandoned; Mediocre; Timid; Condemned; etc

PRIDE = Trusting my own opinion (or those of another) above God's Word about me.

The 'torture' of Un-forgiveness in Matthew 18:34

Un-forgiveness is torture too:

- Wounds that won't heal
- Anger that won't subside
- Impoverishment that never ends
- Paranoia that won't allow rest
- Bitterness that won't go away
- Wasted moments that won't return
