¹Now Moses was tending the flock of Jethro his father-in-law, the priest of Midian, and he led the flock to the far side of the wilderness and came to Horeb, the mountain of God. ²There the angel of the Lord appeared to him in flames of fire from within a bush. Moses saw that though the bush was on fire it did not burn up. ³So Moses thought, "I will go over and see this strange sight—why the bush does not burn up."

⁴When the Lord saw that he had gone over to look, God called to him from within the bush, "Moses! Moses!" And Moses said, "Here I am." (Exodus 3:1-4)

 19 Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, 20 and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you. And surely I am with you always, to the very end of the age. (Matthew 28:19,20)

It's _pictured_ in _Moses_

⁷The Lord said, "I have indeed seen the misery of my people in Egypt. I have heard them crying out because of their slave drivers, and I am concerned about their suffering. ⁸So I have come down to rescue them from the hand of the Egyptians and to bring them up out of that land into a good and spacious land...

⁹And now the cry of the Israelites has reached me, and I have seen the way the Egyptians are oppressing them. ¹⁰So now, go. I am sending you to Pharaoh to bring my people the Israelites out of Egypt." (Exodus 3:7-10)

Our usual question: _Who_ _am_ !?

¹¹But Moses said to God, "Who am I that I should go to Pharaoh and bring the Israelites out of Egypt?" (Exodus 3:11)

God's timeless response: It's _who_ _l_ _am_

¹⁴God said to Moses, **"I am who I am.** This is what you are to say to the Israelites: 'I am has sent me to you.'" (Exodus 3:14)

When it gets painfully personal:

My _credibility_

¹Moses answered, "What if they do not believe me or listen to me and say, 'The Lord did not appear to you'?" ² Then the Lord said to him, "What is that in your hand?" "A staff," he replied. (Exodus 4:1,2)

My _capability_

¹⁰Moses said to the Lord, "Pardon your servant, Lord. I have never been eloquent, neither in the past nor since you have spoken to your servant. I am slow of speech and tongue." (Exodus 4:10)

When we hit God's bottom line:

¹³But Moses said, "Pardon your servant, Lord. **Please send someone else**." ¹⁴Then the Lord's anger burned against Moses . . . (Exodus 13,14a)
