

OCS was founded in 2009 by Dr. Kenneth Hartman, educator and former U.S. Army officer. Hartman was inspired to create OCS while serving on his county's Public Schools Board of Education, where he noticed the growing disparity between the recognition provided to students who were going to college following graduation compared to the students who were choosing to serve in the Armed Services.

OCS communities have honored graduates who have committed to join all branches of the U.S. Armed Services. Since 2009, more than 70 OCS Communities in 27 states and Puerto Rico and USVI, carrying forward the OCS mission to honor and recognizes high school graduates who chose to join the less than 1% of Americans who currently serve in uniform.
