John 12:12-16

#### Palm Sunday gives us \_confidence\_ in who \_Jesus\_ is . . .

<sup>10</sup>The scepter will not depart from Judah, nor the ruler's staff from between his feet, until he to whom it belongs shall come and the obedience of the nations shall be his.

> <sup>11</sup>He will tether his donkey to a vine, to the choicest branch; he will wash his garments in wine, his robes in the blood of grapes. (Genesis 49:10,11)

<sup>38</sup>So Zadok the priest, Nathan the prophet, Benaiah son of Jehoiada, the Kerethites and the Pelethites went down and had Solomon mount King David's mule, and they escorted him to Gihon.

<sup>39</sup>Zadok the priest took the horn of oil from the sacred tent and anointed Solomon. Then they sounded the trumpet and all the people shouted, "Long live King Solomon!"

(I Kings 1:38-39)

<sup>9</sup>Rejoice greatly, Daughter Zion! Shout, Daughter Jerusalem! See, your king comes to you, righteous and victorious, lowly and riding on a donkey, on a colt, the foal of a donkey.

<sup>10</sup>I will take away the chariots from Ephraim and the warhorses from Jerusalem, and the battle bow will be broken. He will proclaim peace to the nations. His rule will extend from sea to sea and from the River to the ends of the earth. (Zechariah 9:9,10)

<sup>39</sup>Some of the Pharisees in the crowd said to Jesus, "Teacher, rebuke your disciples!" <sup>40</sup> I tell you," he replied, "if they keep quiet, the stones will cry out." (Luke 19:39,40)

For years the church worshiped faith. Then we worshipped worship. Now we've graduated to worshiping preaching, and I assume we will eventually get our doctorates by worshiping prayer.
