The End of the Era of Elisha 2 Kings 13-15; 2 Chronicles 25-26

- 1. Jehoahaz and Jehoash: Kings of Israel (2 Kings 13:1-14:16)
 - A. Jehoahaz (2 Kings 13:1-8) Continued disobedience followed by deliverance and continued obstinance.
 - B. Jehoash (2 Kings 13:10-14:16) Promised Deliverance from Aram and a victory over Judah.
- 2. Amaziah and Azariah/Uzziah: Kings of Judah (2 Kings 14:1-15:7)
 - A. Amaziah (2 Kings 14:1-27; 2 Chron. 25:1-28) A moderately good king who was somewhat faithful to the Lord until he sought after idols which led to his downfall.
 - B. Azariah, also called Uzziah (2 Kings 14:21-27; 2 Chron. 26:1-23)
 A better king than his father, but a different form of idolatry was his downfall (2 Chron 26:16).
