 - A. What is the serpent? Who is the serpent? How do we know? (See: Gen. 3:1, 14; 2 Cor. 11:3; Rev. 12:9)
 - B. What is the tactic that the serpent first used against Eve? Why is that important to remember? (See: Gen. 3:1)
 - C. In what ways was did temptation take hold of Eve? Why is this important to remember? (See: Gen. 3:6; cf. 1 John 2:16)
 - D. Who led the first family as they sinned against God? Why is that important? (See: Gen. 3:6; cf. 1 Tim. 2:13-14)
 - E. What is the promise given when God cursed the serpent (See: Gen 3:15)
 - F. In what ways did God curse the man and woman? (See: Gen. 3:16-19)
 - G. Both Cain and Abel made sacrifices to God, but God responded to them differently. Why did He respond differently to them? (See: Gen. 4:3-5)
 - H. When God spoke to Cain, what did He say? Why is this an important message? (See: Gen. 4:6-7)
 - I. How did Cain respond to God's message? (See: Gen. 4:8-16)
 - J. Who was Cain's wife? (Gen. 4:17)
 - K. What characterizes men and society following Cain? (See: Gen. 4:18-24)
