Feast of Passover (Delivered from sin by Salvation)


Red Sea Crossing + Feast of Unleavened Bread (Old life cut off by Water Baptism)

Consequences of the Strongholds of Fear, Unbelief and Doublemindedness ~ Rejected their Feast of Tabernacles (The consequences of fear, pride, independence, misalignment, strongholds)

A God-ordained Wilderness journey ~ transitioning from the old to the new (Set free by Radical Discipleship)

Meaning of the Feast of Tabernacles

- Celebrated after the final ingathering of crops at Harvest time in the Jewish calendar.
 - Anti-typically, it represents the final in-gathering of souls during the end times.
- It was a celebration of the end of having to dwell in tents (*Tabernacles*) as they journeyed from Egypt to the Promised Land. Anti-typically, this represents 3 things:
 - 1. When the journey of life for a Christian ends.
 - 2. When Christ returns for His bride.
 - 3. When a Christian and/or church enters their prophetic destiny having experienced all that is required to make them eligible to leave their wilderness of preparation and enter ABUNDANCE!
