
# 1 Corinthians 3:21-23

"We can see, for example, that the language of 'energies' and 'toxins' promoted by contemporary wellness culture—which locates evil and sickness within the pharmaceutical-industrial complex and a society bent on destroying our 'natural,' 'authentic' selves—is, while not dealing with deities as such, nevertheless a foundational theodicy. It explains why there is evil and suffering in the world (or at least in our own bodies) and gives us a series of rituals-exercise, skin care, jade eggs-to help us supposedly counteract them. It transforms the seeming randomness of cell decay, mutation, and death into an illusorily controllable system...The energy you tap into in a yoga class and the energy you get from drinking a Moon Juice concoction and the energy you get from positive thinking are at once unifying spiritual constructs—the world is an inherently meaningful place with energy running through it - and gauges your personal material contentedness. It's the best of both worlds. It combines moral relativism with a comforting veneer of metaphysical universalism: an inherent meaningful world where you can still, ethically, do whatever you want.
