## Read this...

There are two practices that Jesus instructed His followers to continue to practice after He left them to go back to heaven. We call these practices ordinances, because they were ordained by Jesus. The two ordinances are Baptism and the Lord's Supper. Baptism is when someone who has believed in Jesus goes down under the water and comes up out of the water as a picture of Jesus death, burial and resurrection. The Lord's Supper is a time when Christians will eat bread and drink juice as a way to remember the sacrifice of Jesus on the cross. Every Christian should get baptized once. The Lord's Supper is something we participate in more than once.

## ROMANS 6:3-4

Know ye not, that so many of us as were baptized into Jesus Christ were baptized into his death? Therefore we are buried with him by baptism into death: that like as Christ was raised up from the dead by the glory of the Father, even so we also should walk in newness of life.
