WHEN GOD STEPS IN Christ in Our Reversals

Matthew 1:18-21 NLT

²²All of this occurred to fulfill the Lord's message through his prophet:

²³ "Look! The virgin will conceive a child! She will give birth to a son, and they will call him Immanuel, which means 'God is with us.'"

 24 When Joseph woke up, he did as the angel of the Lord commanded and took Mary as his wife. 25 But he did not have sexual relations with her until her son was born. And Joseph named him Jesus. (Matthew 1:22-25 NLT)

Joseph's not-so-merry Christmas . . .

• Joseph's dilemma: What to _do_ with _Mary_?

¹⁹Because Joseph her husband was faithful to the law, and yet did not want to expose her to public disgrace, he had in mind to divorce her quietly. (Matthew 1:19)

Joseph's dislocation: Where do I _go_ _now_?

In spite of what he could not control,

Joseph kept his <u>ear</u> open to the <u>Spirit</u>.

Four ways that God walks us through life's reversals . . .

1. _Instruction_

 20 Joseph son of David, do not be afraid to take Mary home as your wife \dots (Matthew 1:20)

2. _Insight_

 20 ... because what is conceived in her is from the Holy Spirit. 21 She will give birth to a son, and you are to give him the name Jesus, because he will save his people from their sins. (Matthew 1:20b, 21)

²⁸And we know that in all things God works for the good of those who love him, who have been called according to his purpose. ²⁹For those God foreknew he also predestined to be **conformed to the image of his Son**, that he might be the firstborn among many brothers and sisters. (Romans 8:28,29)

3. _Warning_

¹³When they had gone, an angel of the Lord appeared to Joseph in a dream. "Get up," he said, "take the child and his mother and escape to Egypt. Stay there until I tell you, for Herod is going to search for the child to kill him." (Matthew 2:13)

¹³No temptation has overtaken you except what is common to mankind. And God is faithful; he will not let you be tempted beyond what you can bear. But when you are tempted, he will also provide a way out so that you can endure it. (I Corinthians 10:13)

4. _Timing_

¹⁹After Herod died, an angel of the Lord appeared in a dream to Joseph in Egypt ²⁰and said, "Get up, take the child and his mother and go to the land of Israel, for those who were trying to take the child's life are dead." (Matthew 2:19-20)
