#### Key Questions

- How do I exhibit *integrity* in my daily life?
- How would you define or explain *integrity* to someone who does not understand it?
- How can I make *Integrity* function better, stronger, and faster, even in times of uncertainty and stress?
- What happens to your relationship with God, with others, and with the opportunities God gives you when you refuse to have *integrity*?
- Think through the steps you need to take to put *integrity* into action in a specific instance. For example, what can you do to be more consistent and proactive with *integrity*? What can you do to be a person who is focused on *integrity*?

#### START PRAYING: The Key Issue of integrity

The fuel that will enable us to maintain our *integrity* is our understanding of "completeness." This is knowing who we are in Christ, and what He did for us on the Cross—that we are complete in Him! Then, we can be better able to comprehend that the Word of God is our authority. All you do, as a Christian, is a response to what He has first done in you. Couple that with the application of His Word, and it will instigate the right mark and practice of our behaviours. This is our *integrity*.
