#### **Nature Experiences**

#### Peconic River Herb Farm, Calverton

- Includes a plant nursery, pond with turtles, picnic tables, with occasional live music and other events. Quoque Wildlife Refuge, Quoque
- Rehab for injured animals no longer releasable to wild; trails; local history exhibit\*
   Reserve your pass for this experience through the Patchogue-Medford Library \*
   and ask about our "Nature Kit" – a laminated trail map, interactive nature bingo, photo scavenger hunt and QWR field guide.

Includes an easy trail and a dock with a viewing platform on river

#### Wertheim National Wildlife Refuge, Shirley

• Includes a beautiful visitors center with interactive exhibits, trails, and seasonal programs offered.

#### **Beaches**

## Corey Beach, Blue Point

• This beach offers lifeguards • There is a Parking fee for lot parking Smith Point-Wilderness Center, Shirley

• Includes a Tower Visitor Center where you can learn about the barrier beach/Fire Island. Seasonal events and activities are offered.

#### **Parks**

#### Avalon Nature Preserve, Stony Brook

• A beautiful natural environment with 5 diverse habitats to explore Please note: The Preserve and all trails are closed on Mondays

#### Jones Beach Nature Center, Wantagh

NY State park with exhibits and interactive activities
Entrance to the Nature Center is free, but a parking fee applies so
reserve your Empire State Park Pass through the Patchogue-Medford Library

#### Bayard Cutting Arboretum, Great River

- Includes trails, trees and fauna.
- A Parking fee applies so <u>reserve your Empire State Park Pass</u> through the Patchogue-Medford Library Southaven County Park, Brookhaven
- Rowboats are available to rent

#### **Farms**

#### Holtsville Ecology Site, Holtsville

- Includes a fitness trail, small zoo, picnic area and playground all for free!
- There is also a pool complex available to Town of Brookhaven residents

## Suffolk County Farm & Education Center, Yaphank

• Includes a butterfly house and nature classroom

## Fire Island National Seashore (FINS) Ferry Terminal, Patchogue

• Includes a dock on Patchogue River, a butterfly garden and a visitor center.

## <u>Patchogue Living Shoreline at Shorefront Park, Patchogue</u> – Now Open!

Also in Blue Point you can find a fishing dock at the very end of Blue Point Avenue, where the stream enters into Great South Bay.

#### **Local History Experiences**

#### Swan River Schoolhouse, East Patchoque

• Visit this original one-room schoolhouse, built in 1858

## Weeks Yacht Yard, Patchogue

• Patchogue's oldest yacht yard, still family owned, can be found right on the Patchogue River.

#### Greater Patchogue Historical Society Museum, Patchogue

• Check out community history in the lower level of the restored and re-located Carnegie Library (Patchogue-Medford Library.)

#### Islip Grange, Sayville

• Visit the Historic buildings. Seasonal speacial events are offered.
