Old Covenant Reminder

- A people called out from slavery by the blood of lambs
- A people called to freedom in order to serve Jehovah
- "The Law" given by Jehovah to form a distinctive people
 - Worship: holiness, cleansing, blood-purity, no images
 - Community: how to live and conduct relationships
 - The "Presence" in the glory cloud
 - To be a witness to the nations
- Jehovah rejected "we want to be like the other nations"
- The promise of God's servant, the Messiah (Christ)

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New Covenant Reminder

- A people called out from slavery by the blood of Christ
- A people called to freedom in order to serve Father
- The Spirit given by Christ to form a distinctive people
 - Worship: holiness, cleansing, blood-purity, no images
 - Community: how to live and conduct relationships
 - The "Presence" in the glory cloud
 - To be a witness to & make disciples of all the nations
- Father embraced "we want to be just like you Jesus"
- Return of Jesus Christ and a new heaven and new earth

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Paul declares, Ephesian 2:13

But now in Christ Jesus you who once were far off have been brought near by the blood of Christ.

¹⁹ Now, therefore, you are no longer strangers and foreigners, but fellow citizens with the saints and members of the household of God, ²⁰ having been built on the foundation of the apostles and prophets, Jesus Christ Himself being the chief cornerstone, ²¹ in whom the whole building, being fitted together, grows into a holy temple in the Lord, ²²-in whom you also are being built together for a dwelling place of God in the Spirit.

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Paul prays, Ephesians 3

¹⁶ that He would grant you, according to the riches of His glory, to be strengthened with might through His Spirit in the inner man, ¹⁷ that Christ may dwell in your hearts through faith; that you, being rooted and grounded in love, ¹⁸ may be able to comprehend with all the saints what *is* the width and length and depth and height— ¹⁹ to know the love of Christ which passes knowledge; *that you may be filled with all the fullness of God.*

How do we cooperate with Holy Spirit to make this an increasing reality in our experience? — that you / we may be filled with all the fullness of God.

- Unity / oneness Keep the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace.
 Ephesians 4:1-6
- Purity put off...be renewed in the spirit of your mind and that you put on the new man created according to God in true righteousness and holiness. Ephesians 4:22-24
- **Speaking** be filled with the spirit, speaking to one another in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing and making melody in your heart to the Lord, giving thanks... Ephesians 5:18b-21

Unity / oneness

Given – one body, one Spirit, one hope, one Lord, one faith, one baptism, one God and Father of all, who is above all, and through all and in you all...Ephesians 4:4-6

Gifts – but to each one of us grace was given...apostles, prophets, evangelists, pastors and teachers...Eph4:11 (also 1 Cor12, and a fuller list Rom 12)

Growth – for equipping for ministry, for edifying of the body, unity of the faith, to a perfect man, to the measure of the stature of the fullness of Christ. Eph 4:12-13

Purity

Put off...wrong thinking, speaking and bad behaviour particularly in regard to finance, sex and relating to others. Eph 4:17

Put on the new man created according to God in true righteousness and holiness. Eph 4:22-24

"Do not grieve the Holy Spirit of God by whom you were sealed for the day of redemption." Eph 4:30 but "Be imitators of God as dear children" Eph 5:1

Speaking

"Be filled with the spirit, **speaking** to one another in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing and making melody in your heart to the Lord, giving thanks..." Ephesians 5:18b-21

When the disciples were filled with the Spirit on the Day of Pentecost "they spoke with tongues" in a public place where a multitude heard and responded saying "we hear them **speaking** in our own tongues the wonderful works of God." Acts 2:1-11

Always be ready to give a defense [speak] to everyone who asks you for a reason for the hope that is in you 1 Peter 3:15

Jesus said...

"You are the light of the world, a city set on a hill cannot be hidden. Nor do they light a lamp and put it under a basket, but on a lampstand, and it gives light to all who are in the house. Let your light so shine before men that they may see your good works and glorify your Father in heaven." Matt 5:14-16

"I am the light of the world, he who follows me shall not walk in darkness, but have the light of life. John 8:12

In connection with protecting ourselves against false teaching Paul says,

¹⁵ Rather, speaking the truth in love, we are to grow up in every way into him who is the head, into Christ, ¹⁶ from whom the whole body, joined and held together by every joint with which it is equipped, when each part is working properly, makes the body grow so that it builds itself up in love. Eph 4:15-16 ESV
